Natural hot mineral water flows from deep underground into the many pools and private baths at this coastal oasis of relaxation. Victoria's only natural hot springs has two distinct offerings: The Bath House and Spa Dreaming Centre.

THE BATH HOUSE

The Bath House is a global bathing wonderland offering more than 20 different bathing experiences for visitors of all ages including:

SPA DREAMING CENTRE

At the Spa Dreaming Centre the emphasis is on tranquil spaces, private pools (with children under 16 not allowed) and an array of pampering spa treatments to revitalise body, mind and spirit. Services include a full range of treatments, from Kodo full-body massages to facials, mud and salt wraps, foot therapies and ancient healing stone experiences. Enjoy a Li'Tya massage treatment which incorporates Aboriginal massage techniques.

Where does our water come from?

The hot mineral spring waters flow from an aquifer 637 metres below the surface. The 50°C water rises under its own pressure through the bore to within 10 metres of the surface, from where it is pumped to the pools.

Hot pool temperatures vary from 37°C to 43°C

Health benefits

The water is classified as a 'Sodium Chloride Bicarbonate Spring' (Na-Cl.HCO₃). According to the Japanese Health Authority, the therapeutic benefits of bathing in this type of thermal mineral spring are said to include the alleviation of neuralgia, bruising, breaks, articular rheumatism, stiffness of the shoulders, skin diseases, recovery from fatigue, infertility and muscular complaints.
